#### Communities and LUGs




- term community

- a group of people sharing the same interests
- Linux User Group (LUG)
  - common element: being interested in Linux and Free Software
  - particular feature: regional relation

# Specialities for the Region Berlin-Brandenburg



- cities/places: Berlin, Potsdam, Brandenburg 6 Mio inhabitants area size: about  $30.000 \text{ km}^2$
- mentality:
  - with strong local roots
  - multi-cultural attitude, open minded
  - actions focus on a specific local area, only
  - high level of fluctuation
- infrastructure and connectivity city vs. semi-rural areas copper cable vs. fiber glass

- small groups

  - level of organisation (e.g. state of common interest)
  - members and responsibilities, offspring
  - finances membership fee and support

- supported by educational institutions, e.g. TU Berlin, HU Berlin, FU Berlin, Beuth Hochschule, FH Brandenburg, and Universität Potsdam

#### Starting Point: LUG Meeting for Berlin and the Berlin Area

- started in early 2008

- location: always at a different LUG
- exchange of experience and knowledge:
  - news what did happen
  - tasks (and problems) who needs help
  - meeting in real life
- renew and keep personal contacts
- improve connectivity between the groups

  2014: started with the availability of the top-level domain .berlin
