Notice

HP 64701A LAN Card

Thank you for purchasing Hewlett-Packard's HP 64701A LAN (Local Area Network) Card for your HP 64700 Series emulation and analysis system. We hope that it will more than satisfy your project development needs.

Refer to the Installation/Service Guide

This notice contains brief information about verifying that the HP 64700 and LAN are operating properly. For detailed information about installing and setting up the LAN, refer to the *HP 64700 Installation/Service Guide*. These topics are discussed in that manual:

- Install the LAN Card in the HP 64700A card cage
- Install software
- Connect HP 64700A via the LAN interface
- Configure HP 64700A LAN parameters
- Set up 64700tab.net file
- Verify communications
- Verify LAN performance

Note that `/usr/hp64000/etc/64700tab.net` must be modified if you are using the emulator on the LAN. For more information, you can view the on-line manual page by typing **man 64700tab**.

64700tab.net supersedes the use of *64700tab*, except when user interface products built prior to December 1990 are used to control HP 64700 series emulators. The commands **msinit**, **msconfig**, **emul700**, **db68k**, and **db86**, and the emulator-specific Softkey and Debugger user interface products are affected.

Note that *msinit* and *msconfig* will not be updated to support LAN based emulators. Instead, use the **emul700** command to start up the emulator.

If older versions of the other products are in use, they will only search *64700tab*, which means that they cannot use LAN based HP 64700 Series emulators. Versions built in December 1990 or later will first search the contents of *64700tab*, followed by *64700tab.net*. The build date for a product is located in the *productrev* file for that product.

When Using LAN

After you have installed the LAN card and performed the steps to configure the LAN as described in the *Installation/Service Guide*, enter:

```
emul700 -lv <emul_name>
```

to verify the connection.

To start up an emulator whose logical name (also known as <emul_name>) is **ex_LAN2**, you would enter:

```
emul700 ex_LAN2
```

Or, if you are using the debugger-emulator, you would enter:

```
db68k -e ex_LAN2 (for the 68000)
```

```
db86 -e ex_LAN1 (for the 80186)
```

Emulator Name in Multiple Emulator Device Table Files

Because you are using LAN, you may now have two active emulator device table files (*64700tab* and *64700tab.net*) on your system. Even though *64700tab.net* supports both LAN and serial connections between the emulator and host computer, continue to use *64700tab* to support older products (built before December 1990) when you want the host computer to search for your emulator in */usr/hp64000/etc/64700tab*.

If both emulator device table files are available, when you start up the emulator, the host computer will first search for the logical name in *64700tab*. If it doesn't find the logical name there, it will then search for it in *64700tab.net*. Use **emul700 -l** to verify that the logical emulator name is not duplicated.

LAN Lock File

The emulator is locked when in use. So, while you are using the emulator, no one else on the LAN can access it because it is locked by your emulation session.

Lock information is stored in the HP 64700 emulation and analysis system. There is no lock file for LAN on the host computer file system.

There are two ways to unlock an emulator on the LAN: you can enter **emul700 -U**, or you can cycle power on the HP 64700 system.



Note



When cycling power on the HP 64700A, remember to leave the power off for at least 10 seconds before turning it back on.

Messages

When using the **emul700** command, messages will occur when:

- Logical name is not found in *64700tab* or *64700tab.net*.
- Same logical name is found in *64700tab* and *64700tab.net*.
- The HP 64700 system is turned off or is busy in a session.

Measurement System does not Support LAN

Measurement system (*meas_sys*) utilities will not recognize HP 64700 Series systems that are connected with LAN or configured in */usr/hp64000/etc/64700tab.net*. Some measurement system commands and the equivalent tasks or commands that you should use for the LAN configurations are shown in this table:

Measurement System Command	Task/Command for LAN Configurations
msinit	edit /usr/hp64000/etc/64700tab.net
msstat	emul700 -lv
msunlock	emul700 -U < emul_name >
< system_name > < module_name >	emul700 < emul_name >
msconfig	edit /usr/hp64000/etc/64700tab.net
